Consider leaving your gift to the following categories of work:

- Outreach and Mission (e.g. pastoral and teaching work, Curacy costs, community outreach, work with children and teenagers, support of adult groups, funding and training of staff and volunteers)
- Buildings and Fabric (The upkeep, maintenance, development and equipping of the church building and Barber Rooms)
- Where Most Needed (The Vicar and Churchwardens will direct your gift to the most pressing need at the time)

Consider leaving any of the following gifts:

- A residuary gift (percentage of your estate)
- A pecuniary gift (a set sum of money)
- A specific gift (an item of value e.g. a ring or antique)
